

House Bill 212 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 exemptions from sales and use taxation, so as to continue for a limited period of time the  
3 partial exemption from the state sales and use tax on certain sales or uses of jet fuel; to  
4 continue for a limited period of time the exemption from a certain local sales and use tax on  
5 certain sales or uses of jet fuel; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date;  
6 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 48-8-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions from  
10 sales and use taxation, is amended by revising subparagraph (H) of paragraph (33.1) as  
11 follows:

12 "(H) The exemption provided for in this paragraph shall apply only as to transactions  
13 occurring on or after July 1, ~~2007~~ 2009, and prior to July 1, ~~2009~~ 2011;"

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2009.

16 **SECTION 3.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
